3.1 School Plan of Operation

- School Performance Plan
 - o Winter Data Review
 - Plan to look at Goals with more targeted Approach
 - Area #1 Student Success
 - Increase the percentage of proficient students in math from 44% to 54% on the 2023-2024 Mart CRT as measured by the state summative assessment.
 - We're currently at 53% for the winter, so we'll increase the amount to 55%.

- And increase the percent of students scoring about the 40th percentile in math from 66% in Fall to 69% in Winter and to 72% in Spring 2024 as measured by the MAP Growth Assessment.
 - We're currently at 72% in the Winter, so we'll increase the Spring amount to 75%.

o Area #2 Adult Learning Culture

- All grade levels are meeting and using PLC time
- Adjust Component 2: Walk Throughs
- Admin need to use NEPF and PLC Framework Tier 1 Monitoring tool; becoming too much
- Team decided to remove Tier 1 Monitoring classroom
 Walkthroughs for priority with NEPF and teacher evaluations
- Conversation about similarities of NEPF and Tier 1 (can the same observations be used for both, Admin working through now to use both documents and PLC as tools)

Area #3 Connectedness with Students

- 44% with an increase to 49% on Panorama Survey for spring
 - 3rd, 4th and 5th graders
 - Emotional regulation is the focus
 - Results show that 43% were able to regulate their emotions
 - Needs immediate attention
 - o Outliers are getting immediate attention
 - o Actions taken for immediate regulation
 - Implement counselor's SEL lessons on morning announcements
 - Look into IMAGO for SEL lessons
 - Generate parent support
 - Upon return, encourage Mr. Bandhauer to incorporate SEL lessons on Lummis' website within his "Counselor Corner"
 - NEW GOAL: increase the number of students who can self regulate at the winter results of 43% to 49% (hold Winter goal)
